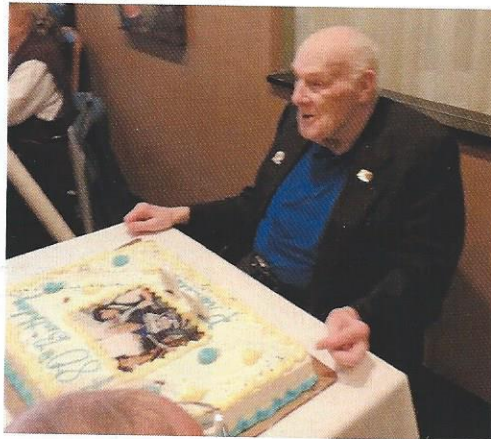


ALONG WITH A HUNDRED OR SO OF HIS CLOSEST FRIENDS...

'Francis, The Big Guy' Celebrates Eighty-Years-Young!

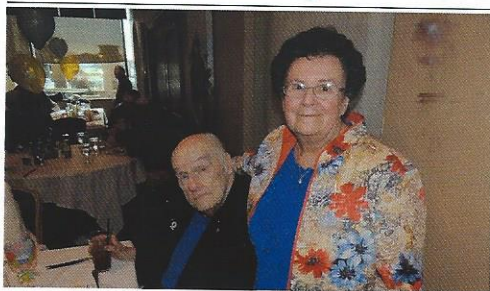
