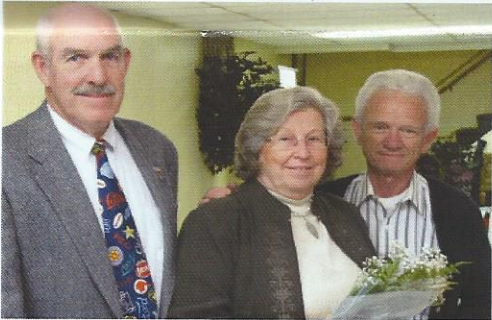

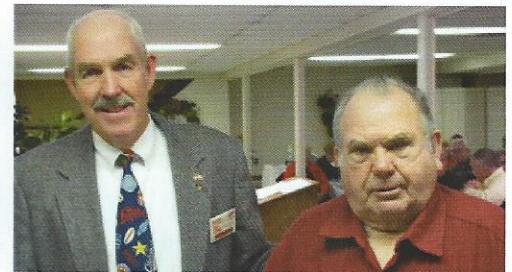

When Paula first saw the Packard sitting at a flea market, she told husband Gary (a guy that knows something about restorations) "I really like that car." The Packard was rough and had been sitting for years. Gary wasn't looking to build another car...

but you know, 'happy wife, happy life.'

In 2007, Gary made an offer to the seller and he jumped all over it. Gary rebuilt the car with a Mustang II front suspension made by a company called Fat Man. It has a new Chevrolet 350 c.i. motor, 700R overdrive transmission, nine-inch Ford posi rear, interior is from a late model KIA Optima. The roof is from a 1980 AMC Eagle. The car rides on 15 inch Packard chrome wire wheels. Being a resto, it has many modern features including A/C, stereo AM/FM with compact disc, DVD and built in GPS systems.
