**Meet at the GM Baltimore Operations Facility - 10301 Philadelphia Road
White Marsh, Maryland at 10:45 am, for the tour starting at 11:00 am.**

From the north and west - Take I-695 toward Essex. Use the left 2 lanes to take Exit 31C for MD-43 / White Marsh Blvd. Continue on MD-43 for 4.5 miles. Take the exit for MD-7 / Philadelphia Road. Keep to the left on the exit ramp and continue straight, crossing Industrial Park Road - into the GM Baltimore Operations entrance. Turn left to the Visitor Parking area.

From the south and east - Take I-695 to Exit 34, MD-7 / Philadelphia Road. Stay left on the ramp and at the signal, turn left onto MD-7 / Philadelphia Road, east toward White Marsh. Turn right onto Industrial Park Road. Turn right into the GM Baltimore Operations entrance, then left to the Visitor Parking area.

The **GM Baltimore Operations Facility** produces the A1000 Transmission that goes into the Chevrolet Silverado and GMC Sierra pick-up trucks, the 6-speed Torque Converter that goes into the full-size GM pickups, Chevrolet Corvette and Camaro, and the Electric Drive motors that go into the Chevrolet Spark electric vehicle.

At 1:30 pm, after lunch at a local restaurant, we'll visit the Glenn L. Martin Aviation Museum, located at Martin State Airport - 701 Wilson Point Road, Baltimore Maryland.

The **Glenn L. Martin Aviation Museum** is dedicated to the promotion, preservation, and documentation of aviation and space history in Maryland, and the contributions of Glenn L. Martin and his successful company
